## **New findings of small Bovid in East Serbia**

Fossil remains of small bovids were discovered for the first time in locality of Popovac near Paracin (East Serbia). They are represented with few isolated teeth, (mostly from mandible) and jawbones fragments of one species. According to the morphological characteristic and dimension of teeth it may be confirm similarity with species identify as *Eotragus* sp. from Brajkovac (Cental Serbia).

The identification of the small mammal material from this locality (*Galerix exilis*, *Megacricetodon minor*, *Cricetodon meini*) led to conclusion that this fauna belongs to the zone MN6.
